Increasingly, researchers are required to submit a Data Management Plan (DMP) when applying for funding, research permits, or other activities. This form provides a high-level outline of the elements of a DMP based on the requirements of the U.S. National Science Foundation. Requirements will vary by agency, and you are encouraged to confirm the DMP details for a particular situation.
